Rapid Identification Tool (RIT) for undiagnosed Emerging Infectious Disease (EID) events

Contract Effort Description:

EHA's RIT tool will use network and cluster analysis in combination with digital surveillance data to detect and triage reports of undiagnosed diseases and provide rapid, most probable identification. They will also develop a web application that collects and analyzes online information on disease clusters or outbreaks (e.g. symptoms, epidemiologic data, location, season, etc.). Although the tool will be developed with public data feeds, it will be generalized to support the analysis of multiple information sources, including private and classified data streams. They will innovate with network analysis algorithms to produce an output of most likely causes ranked by probability. The objective of the effort is to provide a rapid assessment tool that can efficiently and accurately identify pathogens in the early stages of emergence, when traditional surveillance and diagnostic data is limited, thereby allowing operators to implement efficient and cost-effective interventions.
